SPOTLIGHT ON CASWA

We are currently supporting: **74 WOMEN & 56 CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE.** In November & December we received **30 new referrals to our service** and our team provided **1039 hours of support** to women, children & young people who access our service.

Conferences: Three members of the CASWA team travelled to Glasgow to attend the **Scottish Women's Aid Members' Conference** in along-side other Women's Aid groups in Scotland.

Training: One of our Domestic Abuse Specialists from our Children & Young People's Team attended a seminar & training course with Betsy de Thierry to learn more about **trauma, complex trauma, symptoms and recovery** – a topic very closely linked with the work that we do at CASWA.

Campaigns: We took part in an international, annual campaign: **16 days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence** from 25th Nov-10th Dec.
